

Pre-Surgical Dilated Fundus Evaluation

*This measure is to be reported **each time** a cataract surgery (in either one or both eyes) with or without intraocular lens (IOL) placement is performed during the reporting period.*

Measure description

Percentage of patients aged 18 years and older who had cataract surgery who had a dilated fundus evaluation performed within six months prior to the procedure

What will you need to report for each patient undergoing a cataract surgery for this measure?

If you select this measure for reporting, you will report:

- Whether or not you performed a dilated fundus evaluation within 6 months prior to cataract surgery

What if this process or outcome of care is not appropriate for your patient?

There may be times when it is not appropriate to perform a dilated fundus evaluation within 6 months prior to cataract surgery, due to:

- Patient reasons (eg, patient declined, economic, social, religious, other patient reason)

In these cases, you will need to indicate that the patient reason applies, specify the reason on the worksheet and in the medical chart. The office/billing staff will then report a code with a modifier that represents these valid reasons (also called exclusions).

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Coding Specifications

Codes required to document patient has had cataract surgery with or without intraocular lens placement:

A CPT procedure code for cataract surgery is required to identify patients to be included in this measure.

CPT procedure codes for cataract surgery

- 66840, 66850, 66852, 66920, 66930, 66940, 66982, 66983, 66984 (without modifier 55 for each procedure code)

Quality codes for this measure (one of the following for every eligible patient):

CPT II Code descriptors

(Data Collection sheet should be used to determine appropriate combination of codes.)

- **CPT II 2020F:** Dilated fundus evaluation performed within six months prior to cataract surgery
- **CPT II 2020F-2P:** Documentation of patient reason(s) for not performing a dilated fundus evaluation
- **CPT II 2020F-8P:** Dilated fundus evaluation was not performed within six months prior to cataract surgery, reason not otherwise specified

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
