Biopsy for Barrett's Esophagus

This measure is to be reported **each time** an upper endoscopy is performed during the reporting period for patients aged 18 years and older with GERD or heartburn.

Measure description

Percentage of patients aged 18 years and older with a diagnosis of GERD or heartburn whose upper endoscopy report indicates a suspicion of Barrett's esophagus who had a forceps esophageal biopsy performed

What will you need to report for each patient with GERD or heartburn for this measure?

If you select this measure for reporting, you will report:

 Whether or not upper gastrointestinal endoscopy report indicates suspicion of Barrett's esophagus

If the patient's report indicates suspicion of Barrett's esophagus, you will then need to report:

■ Whether or not a forceps esophageal biopsy was performed

What if this process or outcome of care is not appropriate for your patient?

There may be times when it is not appropriate to perform a forceps esophageal biopsy, due to:

 Medical reasons (eg, not indicated, contraindicated, other medical reason)

In these cases, you will need to indicate that the medical reason applies, specify the reason on the worksheet and in the medical chart. The office/billing staff will then report a code with a modifier that represents these valid reasons (also called exclusions).
