CPT II Code descriptors

- **CPT II 4040F:** Pneumococcal vaccine administered or previously received
- **CPT II 4040F-1P:** Documentation of medical reason(s) (eg, not indicated, contraindicated, other medical reason) for not administering or previously receiving pneumococcal vaccination
- **CPT II 4040F-8P:** Pneumococcal vaccine was not administered or previously received, reason not otherwise specified

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
