

Correlation with Existing Imaging Studies for All Patients Undergoing Bone Scintigraphy

Coding Specifications

Codes required to document a bone scintigraphy procedure occurred:

A CPT code for bone scintigraphy is required to identify patients to be included in this measure.

All measure specific coding should be reported on the claim(s) representing the eligible encounter.

CPT codes

- 78300, 78305, 78306, 78315, 78320

Quality codes for this measure:

CPT II Code descriptors

(Data collection sheet should be used to determine appropriate code.)

- **CPT II 3570F:** Final report for bone scintigraphy study includes correlation with existing relevant imaging studies (eg, x-ray, MRI, CT) corresponding to the same anatomical region in question
- **CPT II 3570F-3P:** Documentation of system reason(s) for not documenting correlation with existing relevant imaging studies in final report (eg, no existing relevant imaging study available, patient did not have a previous relevant imaging study, other reason attributable to health care delivery system)
- **CPT II 3570F-8P:** Bone scintigraphy report not correlated, reason not otherwise specified

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
