Coding Specifications

Codes required to document patient has breast, colon, or rectal cancer and a visit occurred:

An ICD-9-CM diagnosis code for breast, colon, or rectal cancer and a CPT code are required to identify patients to be included in this measure.

All measure specific coding should be reported on the claim(s) representing the eligible encounter.
