<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>3</sup>There must be documentation of order (written order, verbal order, or standing order/protocol) specifying that prophylactic parenteral antibiotic is to be discontinued within 24 hours of surgical end time OR specifying a course of prophylactic parenteral antibiotic administration limited to that 24-hour period (eg, "to be given every 8 hours for three doses" or for "one time" IV dose orders) OR documentation that prophylactic parenteral antibiotic *was* discontinued within 24 hours of surgical end time.
