<sup>2</sup>For the purposes of this measure of antibiotic discontinuation, patients may be counted as having "received a prophylactic parenteral antibiotic" if the antibiotic was received within 4 hours prior to the surgical incision (or start of procedure when no incision is required) or intraoperatively.

<sup>3</sup>There must be documentation of order (written order, verbal order, or standing order/protocol) specifying that prophylactic parenteral antibiotic is to be discontinued within 24 hours of surgical end time OR specifying a course of prophylactic parenteral antibiotic administration limited to that 24-hour period (eg, "to be given every 8 hours for three doses" or for "one time" IV dose orders) OR documentation that prophylactic parenteral antibiotic **was** discontinued within 24 hours of surgical end time.
