

## Reminder System for Mammogram

---

*This measure is to be reported for all patients aged 40 years and older undergoing a screening mammogram — a minimum of **once** per reporting period.*

### Measure description

Percentage of patients aged 40 years and older undergoing a screening mammogram whose information is entered into a reminder system<sup>1</sup> with a target due date for the next mammogram

### What will you need to report for each patient undergoing a screening mammogram for this measure?

If you select this measure for reporting, you will report:

- Whether or not the patient's information was entered into a reminder system with a target due date for the next mammogram

### What if this process or outcome of care is not appropriate for your patient?

Some measures provide an opportunity for the physician or eligible health professional to document when a process or outcome of care is not appropriate for a given patient (also called performance exclusions). Because this measure is applicable to most if not all patients, there are no allowable performance exclusions.

<sup>1</sup>For the purposes of this measure, the “reminder system” should be linked to a process for notifying patients when their next mammogram is due and should include the following elements at a minimum: patient identifier, patient contact information, date(s) of prior screening mammogram(s) (if known), and the target due date for the next mammogram.
