Coding Specifications

Codes required to document patient has asthma and a visit occurred:

An ICD-9-CM diagnosis code for asthma and a CPT code are required to identify patients to be included in this measure.

All measure specific coding should be reported on the claim(s) representing the eligible encounter.

Asthma ICD-9-CM diagnosis codes

Quality codes for this measure:

CPT II Code descriptors and G-code descriptors

(Data collection sheet should be used to determine appropriate code or combination of codes.)

- **G8690:** Current tobacco smoker OR current exposure to secondhand smoke
- **G8691:** Current tobacco non-user AND no exposure to secondhand smoke
- **CPT II 4000F:** Tobacco use cessation intervention, counseling
- **CPT II 4001F:** Tobacco use cessation intervention, pharmacologic therapy
- **G8693:** Tobacco use *not* assessed, reason not specified
- **CPT II 4000F-8P:** Tobacco use cessation intervention, counseling, *not* performed, reason not otherwise specified
- **CPT II 4001F-8P:** Tobacco use cessation intervention, pharmacologic therapy, *not* performed, reason not otherwise specified

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
