# **Otitis Media with Effusion (OME): Diagnostic Evaluation — Assessment of Tympanic Membrane Mobility**

### **Coding Specifications**

Codes required to document patient has otitis media with effusion (OME) and a visit occurred:

An ICD-9-CM diagnosis code for OME and a CPT code are required to identify patients to be included in this measure.

All measure specific coding should be reported on the claim(s) representing the eligible encounter.

#### OME ICD-9-CM diagnosis codes

- 381.10, 381.19 (chronic serous otitis media)
- 381.20, 381.29 (chronic mucoid otitis media)
- 381.3 (other and unspecified chronic nonsuppurative otitis media)
- 381.4 (nonsuppurative otitis media, not specified as acute or chronic)

Quality codes for this measure:

#### **CPT II Code descriptors**

(Data collection sheet should be used to determine appropriate code.)

- *CPT II 2035F:* Tympanic membrane mobility assessed with pneumatic otoscopy or tympanometry
- CPT II 2035F-1P: Documentation of medical reason(s) (eg, not indicated, contraindicated, other medical reason) for not assessing tympanic membrane mobility with pneumatic otoscopy or tympanometry
- CPT II 2035F- 2P: Documentation of patient reason(s) (eg, patient declined, economic, social, religious, other patient reason) for not assessing tympanic membrane mobility with pneumatic otoscopy or tympanometry
- *CPT II 2035F-8P:* Tympanic membrane mobility not assessed with pneumatic otoscopy or tympanometry, reason not otherwise specified

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
