# **Coding Specifications**

Codes required to document patient has acute otitis externa (AOE) and a visit occurred:

A line item ICD-9-CM diagnosis code for AOE and a CPT E/M service code are required to identify patients to be included in this measure.

All measure-specific coding should be reported ON THE SAME CLAIM.

## AOE line item ICD-9-CM diagnosis codes

- 380.10, 380.11, 380.12, 380.13 (infective otitis externa),
- 380.22 (other otitis externa)

#### **AND**

#### CPT E/M service codes

- 99201, 99202, 99203, 99204, 99205 (office new patient),
- 99212, 99213, 99214, 99215 (office established patient),
- 99241, 99242, 99243, 99244, 99245 (outpatient consult)

Quality codes for this measure:

### **CPT II Code descriptors**

(Data collection sheet should be used to determine appropriate code.)

- CPT II 1116F: Auricular or periauricular pain assessed
- *CPT II 1116F-1P*: Documentation of medical reason(s) for not assessing auricular or periauricular pain
- *CPT II 1116F-8P*: Auricular or periauricular pain not assessed, reason not otherwise specified

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
