Coding Specifications

Codes required to document patient has otitis media with effusion (OME) and a visit occurred:

A line item ICD-9-CM diagnosis code for OME and a CPT E/M service code are required to identify patients to be included in this measure.

All measure-specific coding should be reported ON THE SAME CLAIM.

- 381.3 (other and unspecified chronic nonsuppurative otitis media),
