This measures group is to be reported for patients aged 50 years and older receiving office or other outpatient services. Some measures in the Preventive Care Measures Group apply only to a subset of these patients (eg, measure applies only to female patients, measure applies only to patients aged 65 years and older).

You will need to report G-code G8486 once to indicate your intent to report on the Preventive Care Measures Group. Once you have reported the G-code, you should begin reporting using one of the patient sample methods listed below.

The following 2011 Physician Quality Reporting System measures are included in the Preventive Care Measures Group:

#39. Screening or Therapy for Osteoporosis for Women Aged 65 Years and Older*

Measure Description

Percentage of female patients aged 65 years and older who have a central dual-energy X-ray absorptiometry (DXA) measurement ordered or performed at least once since age 60 or pharmacologic therapy prescribed within 12 months

#48. Urinary Incontinence — Assessment of Presence or Absence of Urinary Incontinence in Women Aged 65 Years and Older*

Measure Description

Percentage of female patients aged 65 years and older who were assessed for the presence or absence of urinary incontinence within 12 months

#110. Influenza Immunization for Patients ≥ 50 Years Old •

Measure Description

Percentage of patients aged 50 years and older who received an influenza immunization during the flu season (September through February)

#111. Pneumonia Vaccination for Patients 65 years and Older*

Measure Description

Percentage of patients aged 65 years and older who have ever received a pneumococcal vaccine

#112. Screening Mammography*

Measure Description

Percentage of women aged 40 through 69 years who had a mammogram to screen for breast cancer within 24 months

#113. Colorectal Cancer Screening*

Measure Description

Percentage of patients aged 50 through 75 years who received the appropriate colorectal cancer screening

#128. Body Mass Index (BMI) Screening and Follow-Up*

Measure Description

Percentage of patients aged 18 years and older with a calculated BMI in the past six months or during the current visit documented in the medical record AND if the most recent BMI is outside parameters, a follow-up plan is documented

#173. Preventive Care and Screening: Unhealthy Alcohol Use — Screening▲

Measure Description

Percentage of patients aged 18 years and older who were screened for unhealthy alcohol use using a systematic screening method within 24 months

#226. Preventative Care and Screening: Tobacco Use: Screening and Cessation Intervention

Measure Description

Percentage of patients aged 18 years and older who were screened for tobacco use one or more times within 24 months AND who received cessation counseling intervention if identified as a tobacco user

This measures group can be reported by one of the following patient sample methods:

- 30 Patient Sample Method 30 unique Medicare Part B FFS (fee for service) patients meeting patient sample criteria for the measures group.
- 50% Patient Sample Method via Claims or 80% Patient
 Sample Method via Registry All patients meeting patient
 sample criteria for the measure group during the entire
 reporting period (January 1 through December 31, 2011
 OR July 1 through December 31, 2011). For the 12-month
 reporting period, a minimum of 15 Medicare Part B FFS
 patients must meet the measures group patient sample
 criteria to report satisfactory. For the 6-month reporting
 period, a minimum of 8 Medicare Part B FFS patients
 must meet the measures group patient sample criteria to
 report satisfactory.
