
## **Browse-A-Code**


Suppose you have no idea what the word even means, **we have dictionaries for that, Dorlands and Stedmans** can define the word or term for you. (i.e. define fracture)




Browse-A-Code – Search your codes with a decision tree. A great tool to search with. For example, lets find an Elbow Brace, it is adjustable and needs fitted. This is all the information I have to go on, I do know it is a HCPCS code so I will chose "HCPCS".




I know it is under the range of Orthotics, so I will select "Orthotic Procedures"




Next I can see it would be an Orthotic Devise for an Upper-Limb



The next section is starting to really narrow my decisions and taking me directly to "Elbow".



From here I can view every HCPCS code that relates to the Elbow, to confidently choose the correct code



Don't overlook the Icons; there is further information to this code than meets the eye. These Icons are telling additional information about the code I select:




HCPCS Medicare CD – MEDICARE CARRIER DETERMINED



HCPCS OTS – Off the Shelf

L3762 - Elbow orthosis, rigid, without joints, includes soft interface material, prefabricated, off-the-shelf.

From this information I can confidently bill the patients insurance from the information I found.



Remember other search options,

To see a range of codes in a list, enter an exclamation point before (i.e. !99200-99300),

In addition; to see codes that begin with a few digits, enter an asterisk at the end (i.e. !320\*)
